SH-4 CPU

Overview

The SH-4 is a 32-bit RISC (reduced instruction set computer) microprocessor, featuring object code upward-compatibility with Renesas SuperH SH-1, SH-2, SH-3, and SH-3E microcomputers. It includes separate instruction and operand caches, the latter supporting both copy-back and write-through modes.
