California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65) Compliance Statement

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, commonly known as Proposition 65, mandates that businesses provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. Proposition 65 also stipulates that companies cannot cause a significant amount of a carcinogen or reproductive toxicant to enter a source of drinking water or the workplace without proper control or elimination of employee work exposure.

Renesas Electronics does not manufacture products in California and therefore does not expose its employees to any of the chemicals listed in the OEHHA chemical database. Moreover, Renesas Electronics' products, which are sold in California, consist of integrated circuits and related semiconductor devices. These products are not consumer products available for retail sale and do not expose humans to any carcinogens or reproductive toxins through inhalation or absorption through the skin in their final configuration.

Accordingly, Renesas Electronics' products do not require a Proposition 65 warning as they are not intended to expose any person during normal product use. Therefore, the California Proposition 65 "clear and reasonable" warnings requirements do not apply to our products.
